

## **Consent Form**

### **Data Collection and Reporting following a Bone Marrow, Blood or Cord Stem Cell Transplant or Advanced Cellular Therapy (CAR-T Cell)**

For many years data on patients undergoing cellular therapies such as a bone marrow, blood or cord stem cell transplantation or CAR-T cell treatment have been collected and stored in registries run by the European Group for Blood and Marrow Transplantation (EBMT). The registries are housed internationally. The purposes of these registries are to collect data for research and to enhance the safety and effectiveness of treatments and the quality of care. All data stored in the registries are given a Unique Personal Number and nobody outside your treating hospital can identify you as the individual.

Data is also reported to and stored by the national and/or international services, harvesting, storing and providing cells. This is done so that the quality of the cells provided can be monitored.

Data may also be used for local monitoring of outcomes, for example local audits. Additionally your fully anonymised data may be presented in publications.

I ask for your consent to the collection of data concerning your transplant and to the reporting of these data to the appropriate registries and services and to the use of data for local monitoring.
